

First Presbyterian Church Campership Application

First Presbyterian Church encourages anyone who wants to attend a church camp to do so. If financial help is needed scholarships are available to all members--youth and adult--of First Presbyterian Church, for any Presbyterian camp, as well as Pilgrim Center or Moon Beach. Since funds are limited, families are encouraged to pay as much as possible. Winnebago Presbytery may also have scholarships available for members of the Winnebago Presbytery.

First Presbyterian Church has established a process for applying for a scholarship (campership) for Church Camps. All campership applications must be submitted for consideration to the Campership Committee.

Application Information:

- The purpose of the Campership is to help and encourage members of First Presbyterian Church to participate in church camps.
- All funding is contingent upon the availability of designated funds.
- Applicants must complete the Campership Application prior to any consideration.
- Within two weeks following the Camp, applicant must share their experiences with our church family. (ie: newsletter article, *Because You Gave* moment in worship)
- In order to be eligible for this campership, you must have attended First Presbyterian Church for at least 6 months prior to requesting a scholarship.

Policy:

- This campership will be awarded as part of the final payment toward the camp.
- This campership cannot be received as cash or given directly to an individual. Payment must be paid to the sponsoring organization on your behalf.
- If payment is made and the camp is cancelled or you are not able to participate, the campership will not be redeemable toward your next camp; you will have to reapply for the campership at that later time and it will be awarded based on available funds then.

Application Process:

- Complete the Campership application form and return to the church office by the designated deadline.
- A complete application must be submitted to the church office no later than 60 days prior to the camp date, in order to be considered for a campership.
