With all who stand before you in earth and heaven, from every culture, land and tongue, we praise you, giving voice to every creature, as we join the never ending hymn:





He was a licensed Christian marriage and family therapist from 1989-1997. He served as a pastor in a local church in Fond du Lac from 1995-2016 (He started as an Associate and became the Senior pastor in 2002.)

Since stepping down, he served as the Regional President of Converge Great Lakes, working with 115 churches in WI and the UP of MI.


