Each year the Scholarship Committee is blessed to be able to award scholarships to our youth. The Scholarships are made available by generous donations, to students who are members of our church, have demonstrated a commitment to the church, have completed high school with average grades or above and will be enrolled in an accredited secondary educational institution. The <u>application form</u> is available on the church website <u>www.fdlpresbyterian.org</u> and should be filled out and submitted **electronically** by May 1, 2024. Interviews with all applicants may be scheduled to complete the process. **Please note that late submissions will not be considered**. General Guidelines for All Scholarships:

- Recipient must be a member of this church.
- Recipient must have demonstrated a commitment to the church.
- This commitment has been defined as meeting the following criteria in the past calendar year:
 - 1. In-Person or Zoom church worship attendance a minimum of six times in the calendar year prior to the scholarship deadline.
 - 2. Nurturing your faith development in an activity of the Serving, Loving or Learning Teams (educational opportunities, mission activities, worship participation, etc.) at least twice in the past calendar year
 - 3. Recipient is enrolled in an accredited college or university.

We look forward to honoring our graduates in late Spring.

Our church parking lot is a bit of a mess. It has been patched and repaired many times, over the years. It has now come to the point that, financially, it would be more prudent to resurface the entire parking lot.

The Operations Team requested bids from several companies. The bid has been accepted and approved by Session to begin the process, *as long as suitable funding can be arranged*. The project will take place in 2024, at the cost of \$100,500.

Our fund-raising campaign is called "Pave the Way"*. We are asking our congregation to help financially support this undertaking. Fifty per cent of the cost is being requested from our members, with 50% being covered by funds from Endowment. There is a chart in the Narthex to show our donation progress.


