#### Walking a journey from "PERFORMATIVE" to "PARTICIPATORY"

Much of the modern Christian church has adopted a "top down" and "performative" structure of leadership that is quite different from the example set forth in the scriptures. Since the time of the Enlightenment, Christians have (with good intentions) infused many unbiblical qualities into the institutional structures of the church. Rather than focusing on the perceived results being a "dying" church, we need to become more aware of the growing number of people who are seeking God and longing for a deeper spiritual connection.

The challenge before us is how to restructure our current models of "church" in ways that continue to be life-giving and transformative. There are several contexts in Europe and North America that are experimenting with what it might look like to become households of ministry in the years to come.

Earlier this year I was invited to join the 2025 Siebert Missional Leadership Cohort through Luther Seminary. I invested one week of my Continuing Education time for a retreat with 22 people participating in this Cohort at Siena Retreat Center in Racine, WI. One of the main purposes for joining this cohort is to work with other church leaders, educators, and theologians to process through the various potential changes for our household of ministry, to allow more of the congregation to participate in the life and ministry of the church. I am excited to share some of the insights with the Elders, Deacons, and staff at our Officer Training events, and ask that you join us in prayerful discernment as we experiment with this renewed way of being the church.

I will have a final retreat November 16-18 at Green Lake Conference Center to reflect and discern with the cohort the impact these leadership experiments are having.


