- Nursery care is not available.

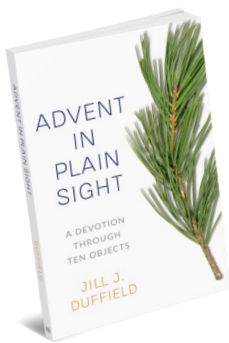
Interim Pastor Nominating Team

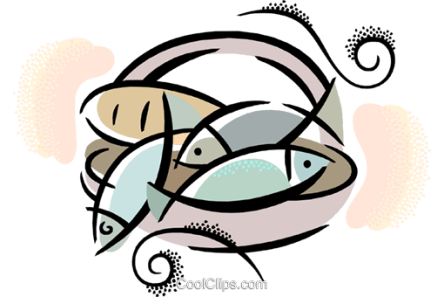
- Food distribution will take place at **GRACE CHRISTIAN CHURCH**. Please enter on the **EAST** side. Park on the South side of the building.

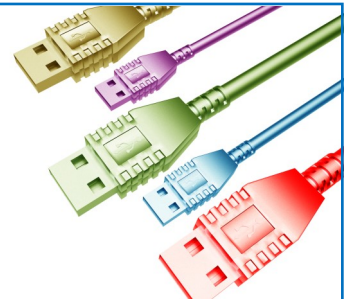
