# TRANSITIONAL PASTOR NOMINATING COMMITTEE

The Transitional Pastor Nominating Committee is grateful to have been given the opportunity to serve the congregation in its' search for a transitional pastor. We are proud of our work, and we believe our work is almost done.

We have selected a pastor to serve as our transitional pastor and are currently working on finalizing contracts. The new pastor has also be met with Winnebago Presbytery's Commission on Ministry. Session is planning to act on this proposal on Feb 7. If everything continues this path, the new pastor will be here on February 14. The pastor's first day of preaching will be February 20. We are unable to announce the pastor's name, etc. until a little later in the process.

We are confident that the pastor will serve our congregation well as we begin our transition to a permanent pastor. The search for a permanent pastor is a process that is expected to take a 12 to 18 months.

#### Season of Ordinary Time

Each part of the liturgical year has either a special season or is in 'ordinary time'. A special season is: Lent, Easter, Advent, and Christmas.

Whenever the Church isn't celebrating one of these, it is Ordinary Time.

Each season begins with a time of preparation and anticipation followed by a time of celebration. A season designated as Ordinary Time follows each cycle.

The word "ordinary" refers to the "ordinal numbers" (first, second, third, etc.) used to name and count the Sundays (such as the Third Sunday after Epiphany).

The first period of Ordinary Time, begins on Epiphany Day and ends on the day before Ash Wednesday (the beginning of Lent). The central theme of this season is the calling of disciples and the early ministry of Jesus.

The color of green is appropriate because it is the most ordinary color in our natural environment.

#### Beautify our Sanctuary

Flowers could be in memory of someone or a celebration of a birthday, anniversary, or general thanks. Flowers or plants **need to be in the sanctuary by 8:30am on Sunday** and may be picked up following worship that same day.

#### Lent - March 2 - April 14



Lent is the annual Christian period of time that begins on Ash Wednesday and lasts for 40 days (not Including Sundays) representing the 40 days Jesus spent fasting in the wilderness.

This 40-day period is a time to reflect, fast, and give penance in preparation for the resurrection of Christ, on Easter Sunday.

This year, the forty days of Lent: *Beginning* 

Wednesday, March 2 Ash Wednesday


**Ending**



# Fond du Lac MobilePack

# Friday and Saturday, April 1-2, 2022 Fond du Lac Fairgrounds Rec Building

So much changed in 2020–21, however Feed My Starving Children's commitment stayed true to feeding God's children - hungry in body and spirit. We are excited to announce **Friday and Saturday, April 1** - 2, 2022 as the dates of the next Fond du Lac MobilePack.

Your efforts and contributions are even more critical in these unprecedented times. At this point, the global pandemic, and its economic impact, have left 265 million people on the brink of starvation. (Undernourished children are more susceptible to infectious diseases, like COVID-19.)



Feed My Starving Children resumed MobilePack events in June 2021, with new safety protocols in place. There is a health screen questionnaire, and physical distancing and masking requirement. You will be assigned to a small group and will stay with that same group during the entire process from orientation, to packing to the closing prayer.

Due to these new safety protocols, we have changed our regular packing schedule. The schedule this year will be:

• Friday, April 1 Set Up and MobilePack

3:30-5:00pm Set Up

6:00-8:00pm Packing Session

• Saturday, April 2 MobilePack and Clean Up

9:00-11:00am Packing Session 12:30-2:30pm Packing Session

3:00-5:30pm Clean Up

Our goal for 2022 is to pack 101,088 meals! The cost of these meals is \$25,000. Each meal costs about 25 cents so every donation makes a huge impact. A donation of \$88 will feed a child for an entire year. At this point, we have raised \$5,000 towards our goal.

During the month of February, churches throughout our area are participating in the **Have a Heart Campaign to raise the \$25,000 needed for this year's Fond du Lac MobilePack.** Take one of the hearts and a self-addressed envelopes from the tree in the narthex, enclose your donation. You can drop it in the offering plate, in the church office or mail it to FMSC. You can also **donate** electronically at the <u>Feed My Starving Children FDLMobilePack</u> website or on the <u>church website</u>. Please include our event number **2204-051SC** to your donations to ensure that they will be added to **our** pack on **April 1-2, 2022**.

Volunteering your time, to help pack the meals, is another way you can help MobilePack. **Five hundred fourteen volunteers are needed to pack all the meals!** Volunteer sign-up is open to the public (online) on Tuesday, March 1. In past years, the volunteer slots went quickly so be sure to register early! **You can also reserve your spot by signing up <a href="here">here</a>. <b>Jennifer will then take care of your online registry.** 

We hope that you will join us in "being the Church" as we love others in Jesus' name and partner with Feed My Starving Children to turn "Hunger into Hope."

February 13 -Super Bowl of Caring
