The Offering: "Rhuddlan" authored by Henry Scott Holland (This was a hymn with a title, 'Prayer for the Nation', and first appeared in the Christian Social Union magazine Commonwealth (1902). A keen musician, he was involved in the compilation of the English Hymnal (1906) and The New Cathedral Psalter (1909). His only hymn combined his two chief interests, social reform, and missionary work. 'Rhuddlan', a Welsh traditional tune often played on the harp, is named after an historic village in northern Wales; its Welsh name 'Dowch I'r Frwydr' means 'Come to the battle', suitable for this vigorous striding tune.)
